Position Title: Trainer

Position Summary: This position is for the Trainer position with the men's hockey Hurricanes. The Trainer is responsible for tending to injuries during games. The Trainer will be positioned on the bench for all home and road games and must have the proper training required by Hockey Canada. Any training that must be obtained before the start of the season will be paid by the Holland College Hockey Program. The Trainer must also assist the Equipment Manager when needed.

Time Commitment: The candidate for the Trainer position must be able to attend all home and road games throughout Training Camp (beginning in early September), regular season (mid October until mid February) and playoffs (later February until late March). The league stops its schedule during Christmas break. The Trainer is asked to arrive at the rink two hours before puck drop for games and to stay once cleanup is completed approximately one hour after the game.

Benefits: The Trainer will receive Holland College Hurricanes clothing (track suit, shirts, hats, sweaters etc) to wear at team events. Invitation to all team events away from the rink as well as to have any training needed paid for by Holland College. Transportation assistance can be provided for road games to Evangeline and Kensington.
